

Caring for your ShowerGuard™ glass

Although ShowerGuard glass stays beautiful for life it does require cleaning from time to time. A damp cloth or sponge and standard household cleaners are usually all you need.

Avoid using anything too abrasive such as harsh brushes, razor blades or other sharp implements. Also try to avoid harshly abrasive cleaners, which will scratch and damage the surface. Or anything containing hydrofluoric or phosphoric acids, as this will corrode the glass.

Water type	Problem	Problem Recommended solution	How often
Soft	Water spots not removed using soap and water	Standard glass cleaner, e.g. Windex®	As needed
Hard	Spots not removed using standard glass cleaner	Mildly acidic cleaner, e.g. a 50/50 solution of water and vinegar	Every 15 showers
High silica	Spots not removed using mildly acidic cleaner	Mildly abrasive cleaner, e.g. Soft Scrub® All-Purpose Cleanser	Every 10 showers
